MINUTES OF MEETING TUESDAY, MAY 19, 2020

Because of COVID-19 Pandemic Stay-A-Home Orders, this meeting was held on Zoom Virtual Meeting App
Treasurer, Patrick N moderated the meeting.

President, Cheryl S Meeting called to order @ 7:35

38 Members attending on Zoom format.

Member Recognition – Bob S., Vice President: No member recognition.

Approval of Minutes from May 5 Meeting – Lois F, Secretary. Lois made the request for any additions or corrections to minutes of the last meeting (May 5th). Toni T. corrected the number of days it took Chris T get to Nebraska to bring his daughter home. It should have been 6 days round trip. Minutes in files have been corrected to reflect this. Cheryl S made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected and Patrick 2nd it. All present accepted minutes as corrected.

Treasurer's report – Patrick N, Treasurer. Patrick gave the balance in the bank account, slightly lower due to distribution of Amazon gift cards for Name Tag Drawing and the Bingo Game winners. Club now has the ability to accept credit cards or electronic transfers, although a small fee will need to be charged to members to use this convenience.
