MINUTES OF MEETING TUESDAY NOVEMBER 2, 2021

**Meeting called to order by Cheryl S, President** started the meeting and welcomed everyone at 7:34 PM She thanked **Flo L.** for baking cookies for this meeting. Proceeds from bake sale go to our charity fund.
